



Prof. Pericles A. Mitkas is the President of the Hellenic Authority for Higher Education. He is a Professor of electrical and computer engineering at Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH), the largest university in Greece, where he served as Rector from 2014 to 2019. He was elected as President of both the Black Sea Universities Network and the Balkan Universities Association from 2018 to 2020.

Prof. Mitkas received the Diploma of Electrical Engineering from AUTH in 1985 and continued his graduate studies at Syracuse University, New York, where he obtained a master`s degree (1987) and a Ph.D. (1990) in Computer Engineering. Prof. Mitkas became Assistant Professor in 1990 and Associate professor in 1996 at Colorado State University, where he established and directed the Optical Computing Laboratory. In 1999 he returned to AUTH, where he became Professor, Lab Director and Department Head (2011-13). He also took over a number of administrative posts at this university, including Head of the IT Department and member of its Senate.

Prof. Mitkas has been the coordinator of numerous research projects in Greece and the US, several of which involved industrial partners.
